Remnds that Mr. A. K. Sharma, Grade IV Indian Edn. Officer may be permitted to take charge of students at a Hostel for Indian students in Nairobi, for games & preparation during the afternoons at the rate of pay of Shs. 100/- per mensem.

The employment which Mr Sharma is offered by the Trustees of the Indian Hostel will in no way interfere with his official duties. The remuneration offered is at the rate of Shs 100/- a month. His salary as a Grade IV Indian Education Officer is Shs. 200 by 15/- to Shs 300 a month.

Chapter III in the Kenya Code of Regulations is applicable to Asiatics as well as Europeans & contains the principles to be observed with regard to private employment.

In approving, it might be as well to add that Mr Sharma must not enter into any binding engagement which will preclude him, at any time, from resigning the appointment should Government call upon him to do so.

Answer (2)

I have the honour to inform you that the Director of Education has been approached by the Trustees of a Hostel for Indian students in Nairobi to allow Mr. M.A.K. Ghaurie, Grade IV Indian Education Officer, to take charge of the students for games and preparation during the afternoons. The Trustees are willing to pay Mr. Ghaurie Shs. 100/- per mensem for these duties.

2. This officer is in employment at the Government Indian Elementary School, Nairobi, which closes at 1 p.m. daily and I am informed that his undertaking of the work at the Hostel will not interfere in any way with his duties and will be of great assistance to the Trustees and to the Hostel students.

3. I share the views of the Director of Education who strongly recommends that Mr. Ghaurie be permitted to accept the offer and I trust that your approval of this recommendation will not be withheld.

4. In Mr. Amery's despatch No. 1182 of the 21st November, 1924, it is laid down that in cases of this nature where expert or technical knowledge is required it should be the general rule that half of the fee awarded should be paid to the Government
