My association wishes me to ask whether of trying to coerce us into abandoning our age old customs by means of the imposition of fines and imprisonment is authorised by His Majesty's Government, as it would appear to be in direct contradiction of the policy outlined by Doctor Drummond Shiels in his reply to Her Grace the Dunness of Atholi in the House of Commons on the lith ultime, as quoted in the Official Report for that date in column No. 445.

If would respectfully draw your attention to the fact that yany attempt to seerpe my people by "force majeure" will nave the very opposite of the desired effect as it causes my people to attach a centuated importance to the maintenance of this custom.

About 70 persons have been recently convicted in Kiambu area under publicly native Authority Ordce, for indecent dancing publicly an obscene and seditious song. Majority of the matives concerned are were convicted hylocal Native Tribunal. Also 12 convicted MENERXK I.P.C. for disturbing church services and meetings.

Sentences imposed very from 60/- fine to 5 months imprisonment.

Following is continuation of my telegram of yesterday re
Kiambu prosecution ending in words "prisoner's clothes. The
Governor is called a big man but whi John/comes he will have his
teeth extracted like a Kavirondo because of the lies he told in
Europe. We Kikuyu are delighted that John Kenyatta has been made
Governor of all Kikuyu by the Secretary of State. Praise Elders
of Kikuyu Central Association for sending John Kenyatta to Europe,
who is stronger than the Governor of Kenya for he defeats the
Governor of Kenya".

You will appreciate from above extracts that any indications of sympathy in England with azitation of Kikuyu Central Association are grossly eraggorated by Association leaders here for seditions purposed. A Recent murder of Miss Stumpf aged missionary lady at Kijabe was perpetrated with obsceneness and horrible cruelty which indicates aggressive familiaries, which song and dance quoted dose, much to inflame. Police are withholding details from public knowledge but if sufficient evidence is found to charge any person with murder they must become public. Situation is at present in hand but you will assist me greatly in protecting life and preserving order if in any answer given in Parliament you will indicate clearly that you support Coverament and Constituted Native Authorities in punishing breaches of law and sedition.
