

In view of the possibility of a large Public Works programme in 1926 consider it advisable to secure skilled and unskilled labour for Public Works if possible from neighbouring territories either direct or through contractors. Shall be glad to learn from you what possibilities there are of recruiting in Portuguese East Africa or in any other African territory and what the attitude likely to be towards any such recruitment scheme.
