Referring to the latter part of paragraph 7 of Sir E. Grigg's Despatch No. 176 of the 9th of February, 1926, and to Mr. Amery's reply thereto in the last paragraph of his despatch No. 108, of the 15th of February, 1929, (both Despatches in Kenya X. 2473/26) it will be seen that a decision has not yet been reached as to whether the procedure set out in Section I of Chapter VIII of the Financial Orders (in Kenya X. 15398/28) may be approved.

Section 25 of the Public Trustee's Ordinance clearly states the Government's liability for the acts of the Public Trustee, and it appears to me, therefore, that funds in the custody of the Public Trustee should be regarded as being a liability of the Government and, as such, should be subject to the general control of the Treasury and should be recorded in the Balance Sheet of the Colony.

The degree of control which it is desirable that the Treasurer should exercise will depend on the organisation of the Registrar General's Office.

Provided this responsibility of the Treasurer is recognised I think that the Financial Order, which follows No. 8 of the Rules under the Public Trustee's Ordinance, may be accepted.

EXTRACT FROM THE PUBLIC TRUSTEES RULES.

8. - The cash book shall be balanced at the close of every month and shall be laid before the Public Trustee, who shall satisfy himself that the balance is correct, and shall initial the book in token of his having so satisfied himself. A full abstract of same and of all dealings with trust funds shall be sent to the treasurer every month, signed by the Public Trustee.
