I have to submit that you will request His Excellency the Governor to approach His Royal Highness the Prince of Weles through the Secretary of State with a view to obtaining His Royal Highness' sanction to this School bearing the name of Frince Edwards School.

His Reyal Highness will recollect that the School was in building during his second visit to the Golony and that he inspected the site of the School.

If His Reyal Highmess gives his sanction I would further submit to His Reyal Highness that we may be permitted to carry the Prince of Weles feature on the Radge - the present proposal is that the Radge should be the head of a "Reyal Impele" and we would then propose to inset the Frince of Weles feathers between the spread of the horns.
