With regard to paragraph 5 of the letter from this Department to the Company dated the 28th of April I am to request you to arrange for the substitution of the expression "Magadi Pier and Depot Works" for the word "port" in the definitions in Clause 1 of the Railway Lease and to make any consequential alterations in the draft letters.

5. With regard to paragraph 6 of the letter of the 28th of April to the Company, Mr. Amery would be glad if you would submit to him before writing to the Company on this point a draft clause to be inserted in the Lake Lease giving effect to the intention explained to the Company in that paragraph.

wishes to offer the following observations

on its terms -

(1) Space has been left on page 2 of the
draft lease, for a reference in the preamble

to the lease of the former Magadi Soda

Company.

portions are planned to contain the buildings already erected on the land over which a lien was given in 1910.

No stand premium is payable in respect of the original area and the rental thereon is to be an heretofore, one peppercorn if demanded. The portions coloured green, however, should be subject to a stand premium of £1167 and an annual rent of £280/2/6d. These figures are based on a capital valuation of £1500 per acre, and are proportioned in the manner authorised by Government, i.e. one-fifth of the capital value as stand premium and six-tenths of the remaining four-fifths as annual rent*.

(4) The sum to be named in Clause 12 as the agreed amount of the capital outlay on the construction of the Pier and Depot Works will be inserted later.
