## RETURN PASSAGE NOTIFICATION.

The form annexed must be completed and returned to the Crown Agents as soon as possible but four months before the date on which the officer should sail. If the form, properly completed, is sent by the Crown Agents by the stipulated time, an officer will be held entirely responsible for his return to duty at the end of his leave or after any extension of leave granted by the Secretary of State.

You are informed that your leave expires on the [redacted]  
 and you are due to return by the steamer sailing on or next before that date, any unexpired leave  
 will be carried over to your next period of leave. When, however, the sailing to [redacted] Africa next after the  
 expiration of an officer's leave is nearer to the date of the expiration than the sailing next before, he  
 is granted an extension of leave without pay to enable him to sail by the latter steamer. The  
 steamer can accept no liability for salary in respect of any extension of leave necessitated by the  
 alteration or postponement of steamer sailing.

In all cases where it is desired for special reasons to extend or curtail the leave of absence other  
 than those stated above, or to embark at a port outside the United Kingdom, or to travel by any but the  
 shortest route, the written permission of the Colonial Office must be obtained. Any application for  
 extension or curtailment must be made before the date for returning this form.

If you are going alone to [redacted], please complete paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 (a) in the form  
 and you will be informed whether your passage has been booked.

If you propose to return accompanied by your wife and family, the alternatives mentioned in  
 paragraphs (b), (c), and (d) are open to you, and you must complete the relevant applicable paragraph  
 indicating them consisting. At present the monthly salary of an officer is £100, and the  
 maximum amount of leave granted is four months, so pay passage in the steamer paid by the  
 steamer.

A married officer returning alone will receive a sum not exceeding £100 per month, and the  
 Crown Agents will be necessarily obliged to make arrangements for the other members of his family  
 to be provided for during the period of his absence, and will consider the

possibility of making arrangements for their passage in the steamer paid by the steamer.
