With reference to your minute of 18th June regarding the method of assessment of contribution to the East African Widows' and Orphans' Pension Scheme in cases where approval has been given for an officer to pass an efficiency bar in his scale of pay our view was that as the passing of the efficiency bar (assuming that the officer's incremental date remains the same) is anticipated the rate at a given moment in time will be the maximum of the lower and the minimum of the higher scale and in virtue of the latter should begin to contribute at the latter rate from his incremental date.

The result of the decision given in your minute would be that the man would lose his pension at a higher rate of pension for his widow if widowed before the formal notice of his passing the efficiency bar was issued and the bar would lose the amount of his contribution for this period which would be unound from the actuarial point of view.

Perhaps you would not find re-considering the situation from this point of view.


