WESTERN BARROW QUARRY

REPORT PROGRESS WORKING TO DATE

1. General. The work on the progress of the Western Barrow at this time during the three months ended 31st July, 1926.

2. Excavation. The designing of the work will have been completed, and has been proceeding over the west side of the wall.

3. Excavation. This has proceeded by means of the removal of material west of the north end of the work now amounting to 15,000 cubic yards, this work will be available for other work.

4. Excavation. The construction of the length of the wall has been completed in this contract and completed during the quarter and the work of depositing the rubble in the trench and filling the filling behind the wall is rapidly approaching completion. The work done of this nature on the wall during the quarter was as follows:

11. Shed Superstructure. Better progress has been made with the superstructure of Shed No. 1. This work is now better organized and the force of carpenters was increased from 101 at the beginning of the quarter to about 220 at the end of May. It is expected that the first 7 bays at the south end of it will be ready to hand over by the 15th August, which is the latest date given for this by the Contractors.

12. Roads. A considerable area of the 30 ft. roadway at the north end of Shed Nos. 1. has been formed and the rubble bottoming laid, the forming and rubble bottoming of the 40 ft. roadway at the back of the area behind the sheds has been completed for the whole length of Shed No. 1. and the bottoming is now being steam rolled.

13. Workshops. Fairly good progress has been made in the quarter under review.
