(Dated 14th April Received Colonial Office 11.5 a.m.
15th April, 1924)

No. 117 14th April. I am anxious for approval of principle that port and harbour control shall be placed definitely under administration of Uganda Railway. Felling states that it is very desirable to begin the consideration of the difficult problem of handling charges and port dues also appointment of experienced port manager not later than January next year,

I fully agree and request authority to proceed on above lines. With reference to the appointment of the Port Manager I strongly recommend that applications for the post should be invited locally in the first instance and the names of any suitable candidates be submitted to you for discussion with Felling if he goes to England.
