As a result of the revised principles regarding the reporting of local appointments of Europeans in Kenya & Uga, laid down in our despatches on 5/2/39 & 8/26/39 (enclosed herewith - app in enc), the procedure as regards the collection of particulars for the Vital Statistics ~~purpose~~ appears to require revision in the case of those apps which are now to be reported in the quarterly return of changes in offices etc.

Hitherto the necessary particulars have been available from the despatch reporting such apps & terminations separately, and, in the case of Uga, from special quarterly returns - see 10228/25/11, 12, 13.

It was agreed on 4/9/40 that the submission of returns of terminations should be discontinued.
