I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Strachey's letter of the 8th instant (15149/25) relative to the organisation of the joint Commission which is to be set up under Article 12 of the Anglo Italian Treaty of the 15th July 1924, to determine the boundary of the territory in East Africa to be ceded to Italy.
