In connection with the control of
the Weeviling on Coffee in Kenya, I have
the honour to suggest the following

1. That a cable be sent to Kenya
asking permission to spend up to
£200. for a power spraying outfit.
2. That should permission be granted,
the outfit suggested by Messrs W.
Weeks & Son, in their letter - Kenya
1888 HST/VRH of the 1.9.25 - to the
Chief Engineer, the Colonial Agents be
purchased and forwarded to Kenya
without delay.
3. That should permission be withheld,
the catalogues together with a copy
of the letter be sent to Kenya.
