2. Satisfactory replies

have been received from

the referees named by Mrs

Bell, and I am now to

authorise you to offer her,  
subject to medical examination,  
engagement for the usual  
term of service on a Clerical  
Agreement, with salary  
on the scale £200 per year  
by increments of £15 to £300.

3. Miss Bell is required  
to commence duty in the  
Colony by the end of May  
next, and you should  
therefore arrange for her to  
sail not later than  
the 30<sup>th</sup> of April.

4. The A.C. Governor  
makes no mention of the  
payment of uniform allowance  
in this case, and it is deemed  
that no provision for this is  
made in the annual Estimate  
of the Colony. In the event,  
therefore, of Miss Bell enquiring  
on this point  
as to the payment of such  
allowance, you should  
inform her that you have

no authority to offer any such allowance, & that she should raise the matter for consideration by the local Govt or her arrival at the Colony.

5. I am to request you to report as soon as possible whether Mr Bell accepts employment on these conditions.
