Re: allotment of Medical Farms

With reference to your enquiry of the 14<sup>th</sup> ultimo, I have to state that there are still several farms reserved for allotment to medical men.

The main conditions are as follows:—

Date of allotment	Date of Application
Tenure	Leasehold (999 years)
Area	1,000 acres upwards
Rent	20 cents of a shilling per acre
Purchase Price	Assessed by Government but remitted on completion of medical residence
Covenant	The allottee to reside on the farm and practice his profession for 3 years within a period of 5 years from date of allotment
Development	Nil

I attach a list of farms available.

I cannot however guarantee that the farms in the list will still be available on receipt of an application from you. An allotment may take place in the meantime.

I have further to inform you that should a medical officer desire to take up any other unalienated farm in the Soldier Settlement Scheme under medical terms, the farm may be made a medical one if the Principal Medical Officer considers that its situation is such as to warrant the placing of a medical man in that area.
