1. I have the honour to report that the considerations advanced in Kenya despatch, Confidential, No. 66 of the 11th March, in the case of Nairobi District apply with equal force to other extra-Provincial Districts notably North Nyeri, Kisumu-Londiani, and Mombasa Districts.

2. The principle of separating Native from Non-Native Administration is in no way abrogated by making these districts intra-Provincial. It has however been found convenient for administrative purposes that the officers in charge of these Non-Native Districts whose headquarters are situate in the same station as those of the Senior Commissioner should correspond through him and be under his control.

In the case of the North Nyeri District, where only an Assistant Resident Commissioner is in charge, this procedure has been adopted for some time past with satisfactory results.

3. I therefore recommend that Kisumu-Londiani District be included in the Nyanza Province, North Nyeri District in Kikuyu Province, and Mombasa District in the Coast Province.

In regard to Mombasa I would recommend

that

from the municipal functions of the Resident Commissioner which will ultimately be assumed by a Municipal Council, should be separated from the administrative and Sanitary Commissioner and that the Resident Commissioner should confine, as at present, to communicating direct with the Colonial Secretary on purely judicial matters.

4. I regret that these considerations were overlooked at the time when the new Administrative boundaries were gazetted. These boundaries had been settled in principle for some time, and their publication was deferred pending review of certain outstanding details. I trust in the circumstances that you will be disposed to approve of my present proposals.

5. It may also be found desirable in the future to group Trans-Nilim, Elgeet, Esurert, Naivasha, and Nakuru Districts under the Senior Commissioner at Nakuru in view of the extension of the railway to Nairobi. But I will address you further on this subject.


