TRANSPORT DEVELOPMENT. RAILWAY CONSTRUCTION.

Extensions of Uganda Railway will commence 1st January. All parties will be submitted when survey completed. The first extension should be completed in 12 months. The line extends mainly on labour and suggests calling for 10,000 men for small contract locally; hope complete by end 1924. Final survey completed shortly. Kileleshwa and Kavirondo Branch dealt with later.

It appears from this that the programme will be roughly as follows:

- (1) Thika - Kericho (100 miles) *July 1924*
- (2) Kericho - Njiru (48 miles) *January 1925*
- (3) Kericho - Inyanga (110.0 miles) *in 1925*
- (4) Kericho - Lili (25 miles) *2 1926*
- (5) Kileleshwa and Kavirondo branches *1925*
