If the landlord was liable for the rate (I don't know what generally pays rates in these cases in Nairath) he was quite perfectly told by the Magistrate that he could not be heard & this is probably what happened. If he was not liable for the rate then does not seem to be any basis in the section to prevent a third party being heard.

What I am not quite clear is whether if the landlord fails to prove that the land attached is not a hut or land (2 a) the land can still be taken for the purpose of the tenant to pay rates ~~to~~ but this is not apparently the point taken by the Hyderabad. But the decision if understood it might certainly allow a land owner who is not liable for rates to come to the court & plead that there is a mistake about the land.

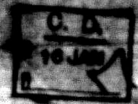
