I have the honour to inform you that with the concurrence of Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Chief Native Commissioner I have approved, subject to your covering sanction, the grant of a lease of 20 acres at Kabaa in Machakos District to the French Roman Catholic Mission.

2. The lease is for 33 years on a rental annually of Shs.4/- per acre; and the grant is subject to the following special conditions:-

- (1) That a wire fence be put round the plot within six months of the grant, failing which the lease will be revoked.
- (2) That the land be not transferred or used for any other but mission purposes.
- (3) That the conduct of the school to be established on the leased premises be in accordance with the laws and regulations for the time being relating to education.
- (4) That survey and registration fees be paid by the lessees.

3. The natives concerned have consented to this grant and the terms are those proposed by the Local Native Council. The rents will be paid into the Natives' Trust Fund.
