With reference to Kenya despatch No.527 of the 1st May, relative to the Fourth Revised Estimate of the coat of the Uganda Railway - Uasin Gishu Branch I have the honourate transmit for your information a further Revised Setimate of Expenditure upon the branch in question, together with a covering memoranium by the Resident Engineer in charge of the construction.

You will observe that the total estimated coet shown in the enclosure to this despatch is now Sher38,042,615 (R1,969,130), an increase of She: 2,400,000 (\$120,000) upon the previous estimate, and from this amount the Resident Engineer estimates the deduction of Shs:1,080,000 (254,000) the details of which are shown in the enclosed memorandum.

The Retinates new enclosed include the want of £20,000 in the event of adverse denision being als in the litigation between Messey, Griffithe and Company and their Sub-Contractors concerning which a separate despatch will be addressed.

The Revised Setimate now enclosed has been reviewed by the General Manager, Uganda Railway, who observes that the cost of construction of the line will be £13,000 per mile and that including interest during construction and proportionate conta of issue of the lean the total cost will be approximately 22,202,130 or \$15,000 per mile - a sum which I think you will agree is excessive.

It would also appear that the branch will not be completed within the time specified in the Contract; on the 28th July last the Resident Engineer reported that he had directed the Contractors that they must complete the Contract without fail by the 31st December and that he considered that if the work was energetically and intelligently carried out it was reasonable to expect completion by that date.

He has since been informed by Messrs.

Griffiths and Company, Limited, that the date of completion which they have before them is the 30th November, and he states that he is not satisfied that they will even be able to complete the Hailway by the 31st December. The Resident Engineer has informed the Contractors that unless they give immediate effect to certain proposals and arrangements communicated by him they will not, in his opinion, be able to finish the Railway until before March or April 1925.
