Priority A.

30th January Secret and Personal.

Following telegram has been sent to Government of India by Secretary of State for India embodying statement which will probably be made by Viceroy to Legislative Assembly 31st January. Statement is sent for your information and must not be made public in Kenya until it is known that it has actually been made by Viceroy.

Telegram begins:-

The Viceroy wishes to make some reference to the question of the control of immigration into Kenya the following terms are suggested:-

"A Draft Ordinance, prepared by the Government of Kenya and Uganda, was sent to the Imperial Government and a copy was furnished to the Government of India. We find that before our final observations were received in London the result of examination of the Draft Ordinance by the late Secretary of State for the Colonies was that the measure was not regarded as satisfactory, and
