Sir,

I have the honour to report that Mr. Hano Dad Karim, a III Grade Clerk and Interpreter in the Supreme Court has been convicted under two charges of misappropriating certain sums paid to him by litigants in Court fees at Mombasa, and sentenced to six months rigorous imprisonment on each charge.

2. I have caused the proceedings to be laid before my Executive Council which has expressed the opinion (in which I concur) that this officer should be suspended on account of the offence for which he has been convicted.

3. In the circumstances I shall be glad to receive your approval to the suspension of Mr. Hano Dad Karim and to his dismissal from the service of this Colony as from the date prior to his being sentenced, viz., 16th November, 1924, in accordance with paragraph 69 of Colonial Regulations.

4. Mr. Karim was engaged as a V Grade Clerk on the 6th May, 1914, he was promoted to IV Grade on 1st
