With reference to the Duke of Devonshire's despatch No.1698 of the 7th December, 1923, I have the honour to inform you that in accordance with your despatch No.118 of the 6th of February last, adjustment in respect of the value of free quarters has been made in connection with the pension of Ali Abdullah, 2nd Grade Sub-Inspector of Police.

2. Ali Abdullah has accordingly been awarded a pension at the rate of Shs. 885/50 per annum with effect from the 30th June, 1923, instead of Shs. 770/- per annum as previously calculated.
