Sir,

I have the honour to transmit herewith a Form of Particulars required for the computation of pension payable to Mr. G.M. Karekar, 1st Grade Clerk in the Provincial Administration, who has been pronounced to be medical unfit for further service in this Colony by a Medical Board held on him in India on the 4th of March last. A copy of the proceedings of this Board is enclosed for your information.

2. Mr. Karekar's services date from the 1st January, 1899, and the total pension to which he is entitled in respect of his 26 completed years of service is computed at Shs. 3,338/40 a year, with effect from the 24th March, 1925, inclusive. Of this sum the Nyasaland Government's share amounts to Shs. 147/05 a year, with effect from the date quoted. I enclose a statement showing how this has been computed.

3. Pending the receipt of your sanction to the pension recommended, I have authorized the payment of an alimentary allowance to Mr. Karekar at the rate of Shs. 2,640/- per annum, with effect from the 24th March, 1925.
