## MINUTES

Discussed in Mr Bottomley's room on July 4<sup>th</sup>

The lease which is alleged to have been broken is presumably the local lease of the Port. (Copy on 24481/25) which refers to the conditions of the contract of 1911.

The As Governor's action in serving this notice without prior consultation with S.of S. was thought to be a trifling hasty, & Mr Bottomley feared it at the new Govt. might take the step, coming in the midst of the negotiations for the new lease, as an unfriendly act. Mr. Burke, however, thought that the notice was probably only of a warning character and that proceedings would not necessarily

follow unless the Govt. took further action.

It appears to be doubtful whether the notice shd. not have been served on the liguidator, clearly the new Cos. who have no lease at all, cannot be sued for breach.

In the view it was thought best to let to O.T.C. deprecating further action until S.G.S had the facts; and notifying those concerned.
