Sir.

I have the honour to transmit herewith a Form of Particulars required for the computation of pension payable to Mr. A.M.J. de Mello, lst Grade Clerk, Port Marine Department, who has been pronounced to be must unfit for further service in this Colony by a Medical Board held in India on the 22nd April, 1925. A copy of the proceedings of this Board is enclosed for your information.

- 2. Mr. de Mello's services date from the 10th April, 1905, and he is, therefore, eligible for a pension in respect of 20 completed years of service. The pension is computed at Shs.2,268/- a year, with effect from the 11th May, 1925, inclusive.
- 3. Pending the receipt of your sanction to the amount recommended, I have authorised the payment to Mr. de Mello of an Alimentary Allowance at the rate of Shs.1,800/- a year, with effect from the date of his retirement.
