With reference to the Duke of Devonshire's despatch No. 1524 of the 1st November, 1923, I have the honour to inform you that in accordance with your despatch No. 118 of the 6th February last, adjustment in respect of the value of free quarters had been made in connection with the pension of Mr. Gabra Mariam, Abyssinian Interpreter in the Administration.

2. The pension awarded to Mr. Gabra Mariam accordingly amounts to Shs. 280/- per annum with effect from the 5th February, 1923, instead of Shs. 264/- per annum as previously calculated.

3. Mr. Gabra Mariam was drowned in the Gulufa River in the Gamo Province, Abyssinia, on the 8th July, 1923. Arrangements will be made to pay to his relatives the difference of his pension at the rate of Shs. 26/- per annum from the 5th February to 8th July, 1923, inclusive.
