With reference to the Duke of Devonshire's despatch No.1333 of the 12th September, 1923, I have the honour to inform you that an increment of £6 per annum due to Mr. M.F.R. Pereira on the 1st April 1923, was not taken into consideration in computing his pension. The increment was sanctioned in August 1923, but owing to an oversight the pension was not re-calculated at the time.

2. I shall be glad if you will authorize the payment of pension to Mr. Pereira at the revised rate of Shs.1,927/80 per annum, instead of Shs.1,893/80 per annum, as previously calculated with effect from 9th June, 1923.
