Your telegram of 20th November. After
consultation with Gowers recommend offer of appointment
Conservator of Forests for Kenya and Uganda to
suitable officer from India on consolidated salary
proposed plus house or house allowance but we are
prepared to offer up to £1800 if necessary cost to be
divided between two countries. We should prefer
an officer seconded for two or three years. We could
not guarantee officer's services would be retained
after this period but any officer who makes his
mark in forestry here may count on goodwill of whole
Colony
