Mr. Robinson

I spoke with you about this & you agreed that it wd. be desirable to send a further tel. explaining that the new reg. must not be applied to personnel who had serving in KAR (To do so wd. upset the system in which we obtain regular Army personnel from the US Army who are recruited for a maximum of 5 years only & under the two years in each period: moreover the thin control exercised when you are in a regard to Br. Army personnel which is not to be raised without US consent & which is not to be made to differ from those in force in other P.O.s for land personnel).

It is written accordingly. As we are sending a further tel., Mr. [Name] suggests that it might be safest to add words which will ensure that

no immediate change will be introduced. New arrangements as to family allowances for all dependents will probably be brought into force from the 1st of April next and the effect of this on the pension position may require consideration. Also we might be liable to some extent to new Kenya arrangements (under the agreement) as to pensionable service which forms part of the pensionable service of the [Name] etc.

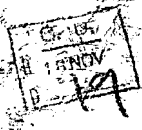
