I am directed by the High Commissioner to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 21st instant, Ref. <sup>Gov</sup> 50597/1920, enclosing copy of communication addressed to your Department <sup>from</sup> from the Governor of the Colony of Kenya and the East Africa Protectorate, together with Medical Board Report on above man. The remarks in the Medical Report are duly noted and Mr. Arnold's Pension has been provisionally re-assessed at the reduced rate of £38 per annum, viz:- 32. 5/- per month, as from the instalment due 1st July 1920. The High Commissioner will be glad if you will kindly request the Governor of Kenya to continue payment at this rate to Mr. Arnold, commencing with the instalment due 1st July last. Mr. Arnold should also be advised that this re-assessment is only provisional and is subject to any adjustment that may be necessary when the High Commissioner receives the decision of the New Zealand Authorities, to whom Medical Report is being sent for consideration and decision.

It is also requested that you will kindly ask the Governor of Kenya to return the previous Medical Board Report held on the above man on the 1st March 1919, which was forwarded to you under cover of this Department's letter of the 3rd June last.
