Salary - £600 by £24 to £700.

Pension - Pension is drawn by
a med. officer in accⁿ with
the E. African Pension
Reg^{ns}, a copy of wh^{ch} is
enclosed. Since the
present edition of the Reg^{ns}
was printed the age for
retirement with out medical
certif. is fifty or after
twenty years Colonial
service, whichever is

greater, and retirement
is compulsory, as well as
voluntary, on reaching the
age of retirement, but an
officer may be retained in
the service beyond that age,
with his own consent, for
such further period as the
Gov. may recommend.

and draw a gratuity in
lieu of pension, after
9 years service (of which
6 years must be resident
service in E. Afr.) or after
14 years service (of which

4 years must be resident
service in Africa): the
gratuity is £1000 after 9
years service & £1250 after
12 years service.

5. If you were selected for
