Sir,

West African Colonies Pension Fund
1918-1919.

I have the honor to acknowledge the letter of the 27th inst. which you have specified, from which I infer that the necessary Treasury consent has been obtained and that therefore the work may proceed.

It would not be candid on my part to promise you the results quickly. I am at present advising the Colonial Office on another similar question, relative to British Guiana, and the work there involved is very heavy. I am also engaged with the National Health Insurance Commission on a complicated question concerning the mode of collecting medical contributions, and my own quinquennial valuation approaching completion a particularly busy time for me in the office. I will proceed with the West African Report as a result of circumstances will allow, but am not likely to have it finalized before the end of the year at earliest.

I hardly know what is meant by the phrase "in as great detail as possible", the detail will be that of the West African Scheme, neither more or less, and the same general will be shown in regard to the various other Colonies under a similar scheme.
