Urgent. How long would it take to cross section first section referred to in our letter 28th April and bring or send detailed estimate of cost. Have you instruments to start four parties.

Sent to Mr. Galley, 25th May, 1920.

Contract will now be separate agreements for survey and construction former virtually agreed. In view of this can you arrange for survey to proceed you coming London meantime for conference. Macdonald must not make commitments beyond personal investigation until agreement signed.

Received from Mr. Galley, 31st May, 1920.

Referring to your telegram of the 18th can have details required in two months. Referring to your telegram of 25th I cannot come home at present Macdonald can sail immediately arriving in England middle of July bringing full details I am of opinion this is the best I can do as I am in close touch with the Authorities and local conditions here and think could handle this end better telegraph whether you approve. Proceeding with survey first section and ? line of second section.
