I was granted a farm (73^b) immediately on
last year's Land Settlement Scheme, have
not been able, owing to urgent private affairs,
to go out. Can you tell me whether the Governor
will release the conditions in my favour in view of
the fact that the delay was caused by my son & his
brother being taken prisoners by the Bolsheviks in the raid
on Kronstadt Harbour, for his share in which he has
received the D.S.O. He was only released in
April & was ill with shell shock & a paralysed
arm on his return. Owing to the death during
his absence of a near relative, much legal business
has also fallen on my shoulders & cannot be cleared
up before October when I hope to sail
and still have the right in aid of passage
for myself soon.

- 4) Can you tell me where I can obtain the report of the Lands Survey & Agricultural department of the colony so that I may take out the agricultural implements best suited in the opinion of good experts for the district, & crops / prospects
