I was granted a farm (736) on not year's land settlement scheme, I have not yet been able, owing to urgent private affairs, to go out. Can you let me whether the Governor will relax the conditions in my favour in view of the fact that the delay was caused by my son & his being taken prisoner by the Bolsheviks in the raid on Kronstadt Harbour, for his share in which he has received the D.S.O. He was only released in April & was ill with shell shock & a paralysed arm on his return. Owing to the death during his absence of a near relative, much legal business was also fallen on my shoulders & cannot be cleared up before October when I hope to sail. I will still have the grant in aid of passage for myself & my son.
