The question of passage is difficult to settle

(see no 31248) but his wife will have to
be recommended for passage (unless the
W.O. decides to arrange passage for wives
& will or for the local force personnel) -

certificate issue

 two months)

 C.A. will issue pay for April, say

2. I beg that you will inform me
of your decision as to my pay for
the period July 1st to September
30th as st. tol. Prout informs
me that he considered it expedient
to leave the country even in the
latter state. I have therefore
made no definite arrangements
as to registration for passage to
East Africa.

3. In order that I can register
for passage I beg that you will
grant priority & certificates
for myself and wife. It will

however, the moment I am
I shall obtain passage, and
any case I do not intend to
leave until I am certified
fit to do so.

In view of the Medical
Advisers' opinion I beg that
you will extend the period
during which I can obtain
passage to East Africa en
route here.
