According to the general practice Mr. Axon is
 not liable to pay tax on his fee as it was
 not laid out of the incomes of the U.K. but the amt. of
 the fee is taken into acc't in arriving at his total
 income from all sources for the purposes of the Income Tax
 Act.

If, as I gather from his letter although he does not
 expressly say so, he has been charged income tax on his
 fee then it is open to him to apply for relief to the
 local assessors. Should he not meet with success
 this office might consider it desirable to take the matter
 up with the inland Revenue. You had better do this in
 the first instance.
