I have discussed this with Mr. [unclear] who are now
bound by the Agreement, I suppose, to pay Miss Lovett £165 p.a. while in this country as technically she does
not exist as a Nursing Sister of the Nursing Service
abroad outside Eng. But I certainly think Captain
should treat her with as much consideration as we did
when £165 a year is not much to live on in this country
as it is as they are at present.

You suggested that I might go to speak
directly to the C.A. on the lines of Gov. 266.3/18/18/CP. inc. It
was decided that no less than men in the Legal Forces
might have, in special cases, a day's pay instead of
leave.

If they have no homes in this country
Inform C.A. accordingly and request them to this effect
by 1st Oct after 30th Sept Inform is received
that after leave should be granted with pay instead of
and that the C.A. for the colonies have accordingly been
authorised to issue pay to her at the rate of £185 per
month from the 9th of September 1918 until further notice
instead of £165.

Next subsequent Paper

Tell her also that C.A. reported, as a result of his examination of her on the 30th of Dec., that she would be fit to return in one month from that date, and that the C.A. have accordingly been authorised to take her passage by the first opportunity after the 30th of January.

And send to C.M.S. a copy of this report and of proposed letter to C.A. saying that in view of representations from Miss Lovibond as to the infirmity of a F.M. and the present cost of living in this country, I.A.C. of C.S. has decided that she may, as a special case, avail herself of the benefit of the arrangements approved for Dr. G. and set out in our telegram of 17th Dec. (60986).
