Sir,

1. I have the honour to state that I have examined by Lt. Col. Prout on 20/10/19 and understand that I am now fit to return abroad.
2. In consequence of being reported fit I have been offered and have accepted a post on an expedition to Bolivia expecting to return in six months, after which time I hope it will be possible to obtain passage to East Africa with less delay than now obtains.
3. In reference to your letter of 8th May last No. 23618/1919. The gratuity that may be paid may be paid in instalments into my bank there viz. The National Bank of India as was the case when I was being paid out there. This is to meet my liabilities in East Africa during my forced absence.
4. In consequence of having had Malaria after frequent attacks of malaria on your service, I have been unable to effect an insurance on my life. I beg therefore that you will consider whether this can be made up to me on demobilization.
