Sir,

I have the honour to transmit herewith for your consideration the prescribed form of application for relief from public funds duly completed by the widow of Mr. A. dos Remedios, late 3rd Grade Clerk in the Provincial Administration who died at Kapsabet on the 13th September last after 15 years' service under this Government.

2. The Acting Senior Commissioner, Kisumu, under whom Mr. Remedios served recommends this as a deserving case.

3. As you will observe from the attached petition his wife is left to support three children who are all minors.

4. In view of the long and excellent service rendered by the petitioner's late husband, I desire to recommend the grant of a gratuity equivalent to six months pay to his widow and I trust that you will sanction the payment of this.

 I must further own that my condition is becoming more and more distressing & unbecomable owing to the fact that the prices of the necessaries at present have gone up rapidly very high and that it is now more than a year that I have not received any pecuniary assistance.
 This has now naturally led me to contract debts with several persons to the amount of over Rs 500. You can imagine my present state will become worse and worse and my debts will daily increase so that I shall be forced to pay with the only little house my children and I possess and for me to catch my creditors and be compelled to live in the public streets begging from door to door all due to the sudden demise of my husband who worked the best of his years to your service.
 For my own sake I pray consider my wretched state and my children who are helpless children and do not have any means of supporting me as usual practice, to be supported by you after my death.
