**Financial Year defined to mean  
1st January to 31st December.**

Provides that where any portion of financial year period 1st April to 31st December shall be payable or chargeable by law, where any law provides for remaining portion of financial year to 31st March portion to be treated as remaining portion of financial year and confirmed as remaining portion for duration of a calendar year.
