VALUE OF HOUSE ALLOWANCE FOR PENSION PURPOSES

Ruling noted for guidance. States as to practice in the past and as to reassessment of Mr Paria's pension. Does not propose to call for a refund of excess payments which amount to a small sum.

In reply to Viscount Milner's despatch Confidential of the 19th January, 1921, I have the honour to inform you that the ruling contained therein has been noted for future guidance.

2. No undertaking was given prior to the publication of Secretariat Circular No. 43 of the 13th August last, to the Non-European personnel with regard to the percentage of cases of pension qualifying for purposes of pension and the amount of Mr. Paria's pension has now been reassessed at £18.520 per annum instead of £18.633.70.

3. As Non-Europeans were not eligible for this privilege prior to the 1st April, 1920, the non-privilege mentioned in the latter portion of paragraph three of Viscount Milner's despatch does not arise.

4. I understand that six persons' pensions have been computed for exemption from the
