Sir,

With reference to Viscount Milner's despatch No. 1100 of the 28th October, 1919, giving approval of the grant of increased powers over routine matters to the Heads of the Railway Department, I have the honour to inform you that in consequence of the revision in the scales of salaries it has become necessary to revise the schedule to which sanction was given in the despatch quoted above.

2. I have accordingly consented to the following alterations:-

(a) Paragraph 1 of the Powers of the Chief Engineer, Chief Mechanical Engineer, Traffic Manager, Chief Accountant, Chief Storekeeper and Marine Superintendent reads as follows:-

1. Appointments, Promotions, Reductions, and Dismissals.

Within the limits sanctioned in the Annual working Estimates can appoint, promote, reduce and dismiss locally engaged employees drawing salaries up to Rs:120 per mensem inclusive.

Owing to the revised scales of salary now introduced, the amount of Rs:120/- per mensem to be amended to read Florins 210/- per mensem.

(b) Paragraph 5 reads:-

5. Transfers and Postings:

Can post all employees in his Department other than first grade officers, also if mutually -
