"It is important to fill the existing vacancy" "in the grade of Sanitary Inspectors but the" "Staff of Sanitary Overseers can be reduced ~~to~~ two"

According to the draft estimate, 1922 the established number of 6 Sanitary Inspectors at £350 - £15 - £450, 14 Sanitary Inspectors at £250 - £15 - £350, & 6 Sanitary Overseers at £200 - £15 - £250.

I take the context to mean that the only requirement at present is 1 San Inspector at £250 - £15 - £350. The last one offered Broad 76 16212 sailed 10 June and must have arrived before the draft was written. The Sanitary Overseers are presumably local appointments as they are to be reduced.
