Sir,

With reference to Viscount Milner's Confidential Circular despatch, dated August 24th, 1920, under which were transmitted copies of a revised memorandum by the Oversea Defence Committee (No. 489-M) on the subject of Storage of Oil Fuel and Light Petroleum Products at Oversea British Ports, I have the honour to inform you that after careful consideration, a site has been selected for the storage of petrol at Mombasa in a building to that already supplied to Messrs. Smith Brothers and Company (Limited) (A). The plans are attached on the slips which are transmitted for your information, and your approval is sought for the proposal, in accordance with paragraph 14 of the memorandum under reference.

2. It is proposed that godown premises which should be leased at a nominal rent solely to the storage of all petroleum products: periodic shortages of petrol are experienced here owing to the lack of storage room, and it is considered expedient to extend this facility as soon as possible.

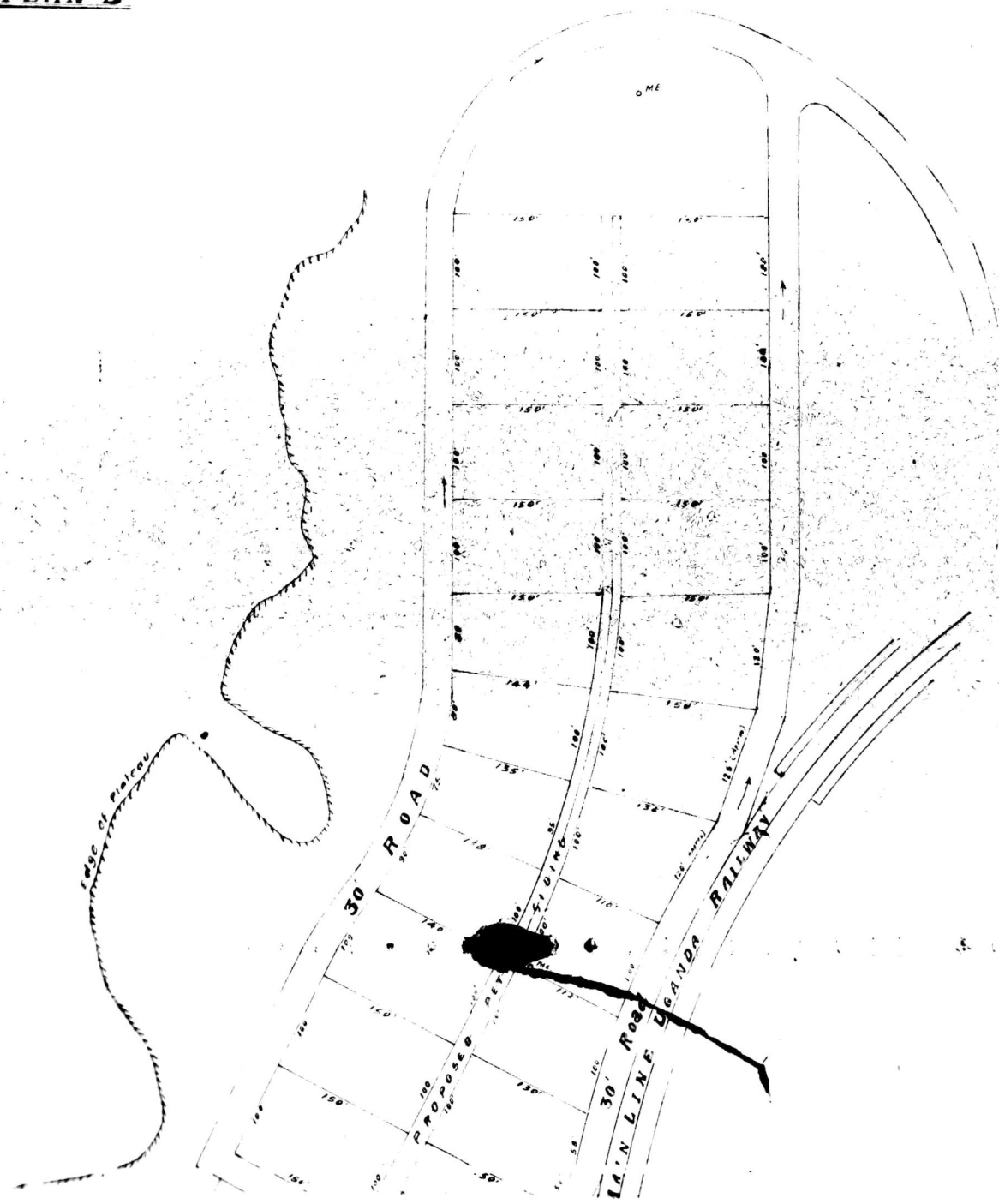
