As requested in the third paragraph of your despatch No. 1208 of 3rd August, I have the honour to transmit herewith a copy of a letter from the Acting Commissioner of Mines furnishing particulars of the sole prospecting licences and mineral leases which are at present current in the Colony or are about to be granted.

2. Those which have already been granted have been approved by the Governor in accordance with the provisions of the Mining Ordinance and Regulations.

3. In regard to the proposed concession to search for coal and oil at the Coast, I would refer to your despatch No. 824 of 23rd May, 1921. The issue of the necessary licence is in train.

4. I trust that the information herein conveys all the particulars required. I presume that you do not desire to be furnished with details of all ordinary prospecting licences that are issued or of the pegging of ordinary claims.

YOUR S.19783/84 of 9.9.1921.

With reference to the Secretarial despatch of 19.7.1921 No. 1308 of the 3rd ultmo, the following are particulars of current sole prospecting licences and similar privileges. It is presumed that the Secretary of State does not wish to be informed of ordinary claims pegged.

1. Six mineral leases over a total of 226 acres about to be granted to Kenya Graphite Corporation at Tullimani Hill near Naivasha (Your S.22436/7).
2. Fifteen gold leases over a total of approximately 263 acres about to be granted to the Kenya Mining Company Ltd. at Ollercombe Hill, margin of Mount Kenya (Your S.21359/8/7).
3. Two mineral leases over a total of 40 acres about to be granted to Messrs Lawley & Anderson near Kajiado (Your S.5416/216).
4. Sole prospecting licences Nos. 24 & 28 dated 28.10.1920 granted to Sir Northrup Milligan near Tonyo Bapuk (Your S.21358/7).
5. Sole prospecting licences Nos. 26 & 27 dated 8.2.21 and re-numbered 15,4,21 granted to Sir Northrup Milligan near Mount Elgon/Elgirion in the Masai Reserve (Your S.21359).
6. Sole prospecting licence No. 33 dated 27.8.21 granted to Messrs Holden & Co., Elgirion Mount Elgirion in the Masai Reserve (Your S.21358/10/8).

7. Sole prospecting license No.25 dated 11.4.22 granted to Brown Bird & Co., Marine Hill south of Maproom (your S.4359).
8. Sole prospecting license No.32 dated 27th July 1922 granted to J. Kamp Farm No.4114 Trans Knoin (your S.21359/6/6).
9. Sole prospecting license No.33 dated 27th July 1922 granted to Messrs over the Boundary Hill Mine over a portion of the crater of Mount Dwyka (your S.21359/6/6).
- do. Coastal Mining Corporation over 32,000 square miles licence about to be completed (your S.21781/63).
