The tone of this telegram "gravely perturbed" and "humbly beg" is much better than those from Uganda. We should take note of the statement that elected members of the Legislative Council consider that a greater reduction on the 31st of March next than that now authorised will be justified. But, how is the Committee to arrive at the cost of living on the 31st of March next? Is it to be a Committee of minor prophets? Ack.receipt briefly by telegram expressing regret that the decision which was arrived at after very careful consideration with the Governor cannot be reconsidered -
And follow up by a despatch writing as to the alleged pliedge as in the draft despatch to Uganda? and writing also again the last paragraph of that despatch.

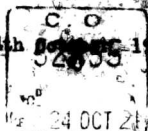

467 21st October. Following telegram is sent at the request of Association of European Civil Service begins Kenya Civil Service gravely perturbed by proposed non fulfilment of Lord Milner's pledge that no reconsideration of local allowance would take place before 31st March next and then only in the event of fall in florin prices. They submit that present slight reduction in cost of living will be more than counterbalanced by effects of Income Tax and increased customs and that any revision of local allowance is at present unwarrantable. Humbly request minimum permanent increase of 30 per cent on substantial salaries of general staff with adjustment of (anomalous) and fluctuating non pensionable allowances 20 per cent. They ask that the telegraphic assurance of Secretary of State for the Colonies that Lord Milner's promise stands good ends. This message framed at largely attended meeting Civil Service in Nairobi 15th October endorsed by similar meetings Mombasa and Kisumu. Budget 1922 has been revised on basis of reduction of local allowance from 50 per cent to 25 per cent but Committee of Legislative Council has been appointed to examine cost of living on 31st March next as elected members consider greater reduction will be justified. Consider it impossible to arrive at actual cost of reduction in the cost of living but that reduction in local allowance 25 per cent reasonable. Unable to support suggestion as permanent increase of salaries and adhere views of paragraph No.4 my despatch 27th June Confidential No.153.
