With reference to your despatch No.1439 of the 20th of September and previous correspondence, I have the honour to recommend that the two posts of European Pilot for which provision is made under item 4 on page 105 of the Sanctioned Estimates for 1921 be added to the list of permanent and pensionable appointments.

2. There seems no doubt that these posts will be permanently required, and that the officers holding the appointments gain by experience and become more valuable.
