With reference to my despatch No. 1632 of 24th November, I have the honour to inform you that I have approved the issue of two sole prospecting licences over areas of 5 square miles each near Mt. Lolgorie Marsa District, V. S. A. Reserve, to Sir Northrup Hamilton dated 18th December.

2 These licences are in substitution for those issued to the same gentleman, Nos. 26 and 27 dated 8th February and 13th April respectively, which are mentioned in paragraph 5 of the letter dated 17th September from the Commissioner of Mines, a copy of which was enclosed in Lieutenant Colonel Notley's despatch No. 1349 of 26th September.

3. The native authorities were consulted prior to the issue of these new licences. The Commissioner of Mines recommended their issue on the ground that the licensee had done a large amount of work on his earlier licences and that he had expended a large amount of money during the year for which the new licences were current, leases would be applied for.
